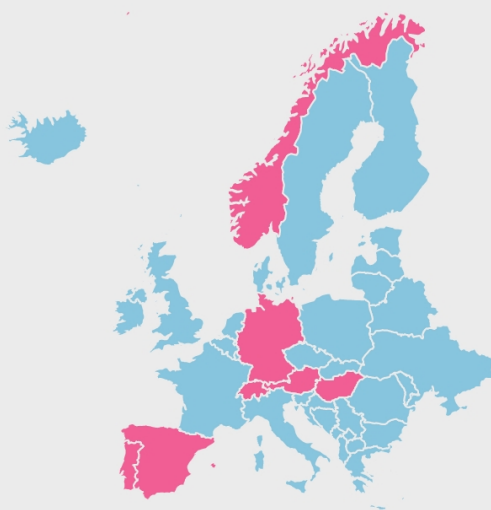
S U R V E Y

The survey took place from August 1st up to December 15th 2019 in the framework of the project «European Digital Treasures: Management of centennial archives in the 21st century».

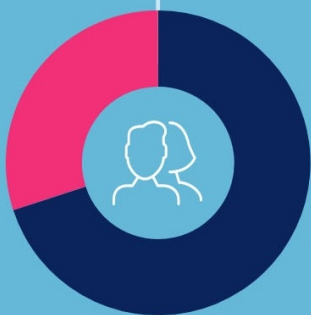
889 validated responses from senior users (over 60).

Countries: Hungary, Norway, Austria, Portugal, Malta, Germany, Switzerland and Spain.

The main goal of the survey is to identify pan-European fields of interests and acquire more knowledge about the needs of silver researcher's community.



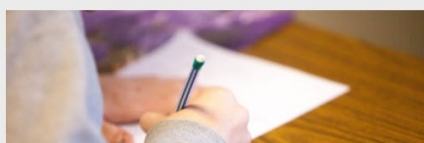

GENDER

Senior users are eminently **male (70%)**, exceeding more than double the percentage of **female users (30%)**.

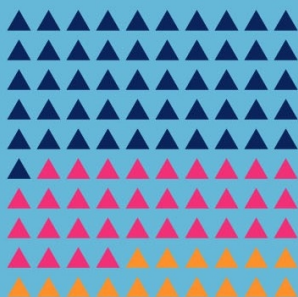

EDUCATION AND CAREER

60% of silver users have **university studies**, and professional careers mainly related to **history, education and public administration**.

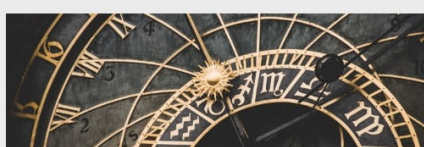

MOTIVATION

The main reasons to visit the archives are: to **conduct family history/genealogical research (41%)**, **personal (26%)** and **professional research (13%)**.

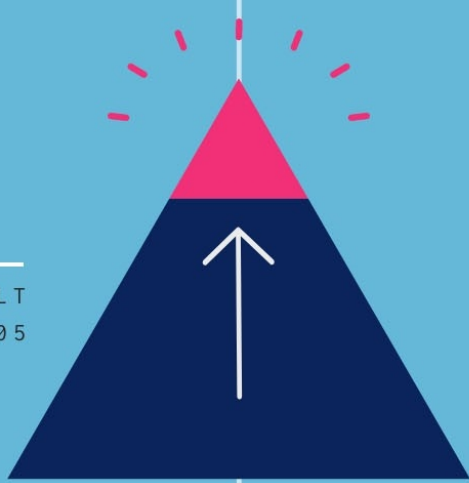

70% of the respondents have been using the archives for **more than three years**.

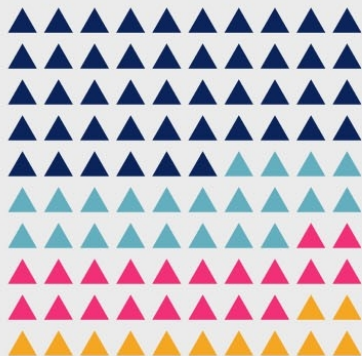

SATISFACTION

Overall satisfaction with **archives infrastructures and services** are **high** (all items are rated between "very good" and "adequate").

REWARDS

Apart from **accomplish information needs (36%)** and **study and learning (17%)**, options like **personal satisfaction and wellbeing (16%)** or **leisure (10%)** are very important when assessing their visit to the archives.

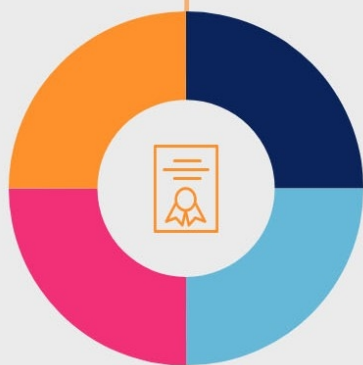

Senior users claim for **digital and technical modernization of the archives**.

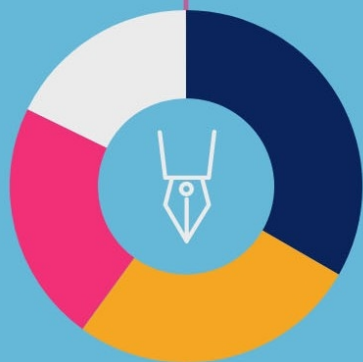

TOP-RATED

The aspects that senior users find more interesting in the archives are related to: the **professionalism of the staff**, the **increasing digitalization of the vast collections**, the **quality of the heritage**; and the **ordering and delivering systems**.

VOLUNTEERING

15% of respondents would collaborate in projects of local history, followed by a **12% that would participate in transcribing tasks**, **10% in scanning** and **8% in indexing activities**.
